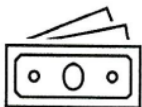

Saving Water starts with teaching your children, here are some ways to help you to help them.?

Be Drain Safe

“It may seem like toilets and drains can handle anything – but you shouldn’t throw away food, oils, wet wipes or anything other than pee, paper, and poo! **How it Helps:** This practice helps prevent blockages in the plumbing system and protects our waterways from contamination. Instead, use compost or bins for disposal.

Build something with them to catch the rain!

“Re-purpose old cups and used jars as rain catchers! With your parent or guardian’s permission, place them in safe spots outside to catch droplets when it rains. Then, use this to water plants in your home!”

Challenge them to do the research: where drinking water comes from, the problems it faces, and how you can help. Consider visiting a local water treatment plant.

How it Helps: Understanding water sources and issues raises awareness about water conservation and encourages proactive solutions.

Challenge: Use gloves and a trash bag to pick up litter on your way home from school.

How it Helps: Keeping local areas clean prevents litter from entering storm drains and waterways, protecting

Challenge: Design a poster for World Reef Day to show the value of reefs and discourage single-use plastics.

How it Helps: Raising awareness through art helps educate others about the importance of marine life and reducing plastic pollution. aquatic environments.
